

OTHER CONFERENCE EVENTS

LOBBY DISPLAY CRITERIA-

Lobby displays are not to exceed 6 feet long (length of table top), 3 feet deep, 8 feet tall. Each troupe is responsible for all supplies and materials needed to construct the display. Electricity is NOT available for lobby displays.

ORIGINALITY.....	20 POINTS
THEME.....	20 POINTS
VISUAL APPEARANCE	20 POINTS
TROUPE PROMOTION & TROUPE ACTIVITIES.....	20 POINTS
SCHOOL/COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT.....	20 POINTS

Your honor troupe application book may NOT be a part of your lobby display.

Additional info ---

The area where the lobby displays will be does **NOT** have electricity!

(To get electricity each school that wanted electricity for their display would need to complete an application form and pay \$32.00 for Century II to provide electricity to that location.)

Also - the **DIMENSIONS** are the same as the table tops they will provide -- **6' long tables, 3' deep and no more than 8' high.** Schools participating in the lobby displays (be sure to indicate that on your registration) will be assigned a table. Do NOT move tables to different locations - the Hyatt will be placing them according to fire safety regulations.

(Of course you can use the space where the table was and not use the table if you don't need the table for your display. We'll just need to ask Hyatt staff to remove the table.)

KANSAS ADMINISTRATOR AWARD

1. Any sponsor may nominate a school administrator. Only one nomination per school will be considered. If you have co-administrators who need to be nominated together you may do so; however, we are trying to honor the individual who has supported theatre physically (being there) and financially (assisting with needs).
2. Sponsor-signed nominations are to be in the form of a letter on school letterhead. The letter should detail the support this administrator has shown. Support may be long-term and not just for a single year.
3. The letter should be accompanied by supporting materials (photos, testimonials, letters to the editor, etc.)
4. All nominations are **DUE** when you mail in your registration forms.

SOCIAL SERVICE AWARD

1. Each school may select one student to be recognized for their contributions to the community as a Thespian. The criteria for selection may come about as the result of one major thespian community project, or as the result of multiple thespian-related community projects. (For example, being a Candy-Striper would not count unless it was done as a troupe Thespian community service project.)
2. The selection process is up to the sponsor. Students may vote and the winner receives the stamp of approval of the sponsor or the sponsor may select the individual.
3. Each submission should include two items:
 - a. A picture of the student.
 - b. A letter on school letterhead which was written and signed by the sponsor.
4. Submit this picture and letter with your application. State board members will create a display for these students at the conference.
5. The Community Involvement Award winners will be recognized before the entire assembly at the conference.
6. There will be no one over-all winner, as we consider all students who have been nominated for this award to be winners.
